

POST IT NOTE ACRYLIC FRAME TEACHER'S GIFT

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Supplies:

- 4" x 6" acrylic photo frame
- scrapbook paper (red, green, white, brown)
as well as patterned paper for insert (background of project)
- Apple - "Recess" cricut cartridge
- embossing folder - "Swiss Dots" by Cuttlebug
- white gelly roll pen
- white ink pad with sponge or dobber
- black ink (for sentiment stamp)
- white chalkboard marker
- chalkboard vinyl
- red & white dotted washi tape
- "Photo Labels" punch by EK Success
- "Just a Note" stamp -
"The Charmed Life" by Scrappy Moms Stamps
- Post It notes pad
- Zig 2-way glue

Miscellaneous Tools:

- Cricut die cutting machine
- Cuttlebug
- ATG (adhesive tape gun)
- paper trimmer
- scissors
- Tweezer Bees
- glass block for stamping

Directions:

1. Cut Apple from Recess cricut cartridge at 2" (do not use Real Dial size)
2. Dash lines around Apple are completed before you run through embossing machine.
3. Stamp sentiment on apple.
4. Run red layer of apple through embossing machine using Swiss Dots folder.
5. Ink around edges of apple with white ink using sponge or dobber.
6. Assemble apple according placement on Recess handbook.
7. Punch out chalkboard sign using Photo Label punch and personalize as you want. Set aside to dry.
8. Cut patterned paper to fit inside frame.
9. Add a strip of washi tape to edge of paper.
10. Before adhering embellishments to paper - assemble placement with post it note to center everything. Adhere apple and chalkboard to side of paper. Insert into frame.
11. Place Post It Notes pad on top of frame using ATG or by taking off back paper of notes. Use over and over by replacing the Post It notes as needed.
